


# Total Grain Supply

(Western Canada Production and Carry-In Stock)




# Disposition of Western Grain – 2017-18 CY







# Summary



- In the past 10 years, US traffic volumes have approximately doubled – 20% increase in the past 6 years
- Post CWB single desk increase can be seen in the wheat & durum movements
- Canola Seed exports move mostly offshore and through the Western Ports
- Canola meal and oil move predominantly into the US markets
- Soybean movements have surged in the last four years


